Through our long-established Compassionate Listening workshops, as well as new offerings like our monthly Compassion Circles, we expanded our ability to nourish connection and rekindle hope in a world that often feels fractured and divisive.

Our Global Impact

- **Worldwide Reach:** Participants and facilitator trainees came from 26 countries – a testament to the universal need for Compassionate Listening on every continent.
- **Governing Board Established:** This year, we formalized our Governing Board, strengthening our foundation and ensuring that the Compassionate Listening Project continues to grow with integrity, stability, and shared leadership.
- **Scholarships for Access and Equity:** Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, we awarded over \$10,000 in scholarships this year, ensuring that people from diverse backgrounds and regions could participate, learn, and lead.
- **Expanding Impact:** Compassionate Listening principles are now being applied and integrated in 36 organizations worldwide, supporting peacebuilding, community building and personal transformation in settings ranging from hospitals and universities to intentional communities and conflict zones.
